Welcome to term 3,

Halfway through term 2 we welcomed Eva Xu as our new tutor for Mandarin. Eva is currently running 2 classes a week 1, Mandarin for Beginners and 2, Mandarin for Native Speakers. We welcome Eva and look forward to all the wonderful learning she will do with the students in term 3.

Bianca Rogers-Mott also joined the team as our new French tutor. We are excited to have French back on offer. The 2 classes, French for Intermediates and French for Advanced students will continue where they left off after Shae. There is a new class, French for Beginners for any new students.

Our classes begin on Monday 24th July and run till Friday 29th September.

Before class

As some of our classes start after 3.15pm, it is up to you to supervise your child. We are unable to provide this supervision however, you can enrol your child into the Afterschool Care Programme, through Yuki. This is an important safety measure as there are often a number of other people around the school and in case we ever have an emergency after school hours. If a tutor is sick, and you have another session with us, you will need to come and supervise your child before that session.

Safety

Please come into the class, unless alternative arrangements have been made, and sign your child out. We have it noted if your child is going between us and the Afterschool Care Programme. It is important that we know who your child is going home with and whether your child is still on the school premises, in case of an emergency. Please indicate, on your enrolment form, if your child has permission to walk/bike home.

Illnesses and non-attendance

We realise that from time to time, children cannot attend a lesson due to illness or other circumstances. It is our policy to not provide a refund unless it is due to the tutor being ill or the tutor has changed the date of the class and your child/ren are unable to attend. We also appreciate all medical information on our forms to be filled in accurately, it is important to know if your child has allergies we need to be aware of.

We are aware, that from time to time, our staff may get sick. We do notify you as soon as we know. Please ensure we have up to date information to make it easier for us to get hold of you.

If your child is absent from school, due to illness, they are unable to attend our classes that day. Can you please notify us through e-mail or on 0272276752, if they are unable to attend?

Drop offs and pick ups

When dropping off your child/ren, please remind them to respect the property around the school. I would like to say thank you to those people who pick up their child/ren on time and remember to sign their children out. I wish to remind you that our tutors do have other commitments after classes. We would appreciate your assistance in picking up and signing your child/ren out promptly. We do have a policy of \$5 per 5 minutes late. We are understanding, in cases of emergencies.
